James Harry Aurouze, Sr., 83 of Waldorf, was reunited with his beloved wife Willa on their 61st wedding anniversary on Friday, March 29th, 2024.

Jim was born December 3, 1940 in Washington, PA, just outside of Pittsburgh, the son of the late Harry Jon and Gladys (Roche) Aurouze. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his younger brother Gary Wayne Aurouze.

After serving 4 years in the United States Air Force following his high school graduation, he met and married his loving wife Willa Jane (Trout) on March 29, 1963. They spent a wonderful 57 years together before her passing on March 26, 2020.

He is survived by his loving children James Jr. and Karen, his son-in-law David, and his beloved grandchildren Michael and Logan.
