James "Jimmy" Dodohara, age 51 of Indian Head, MD, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, September 30, 2015 at the University of MD Charles Regional Medical Center in La Plata, MD with his family by his side.

Left to cherish loving memories are his wife Jennifer, his son Jake, his father Hiroshi, his sister Cathy (Donnie) Cooper; a niece and several nephews.

Jimmy graduated from Henry E. Lackey High School in 1982 and was a lifelong resident of Charles County, MD. He spent many years as a software developer for the U.S. Navy. Jimmy was well known for his love of music and spent over 30 years playing his trumpet with the Southern Maryland Concert Band, the College of Southern Maryland's Solid Brass, and in the pit orchestra at the Port Tobacco Players. 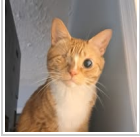
