



## James Louis Scott

April 22, 1934 - February 1, 2018

James Louis Scott, better known as Poppy, Scotty, Uncle Lukey, Jay and Buzz, 83 of LaPlata, MD, died at home on February 1, 2018, after a lengthy illness. Louis was born in Washington, DC, on April 22, 1934. He was the son of the late Mary Blanche Welch Scott and Joseph Leo Scott.

Scotty served in the U.S. Airforce from 1953-1957 and then worked at The Naval Ordnance Station, Indian Head, MD for 34 years. He worked in the nitroglycerin plant from 1957 to 1968 and then served as a government firefighter from 1968 to 1989.

Jay enjoyed eating crabs, listening to Bluegrass music, camping, cheering for the Redskins, and spending time with his family.

Poppy is survived by his wife of 59 years, Shirley Mae Huntt Scott, his sons, Mark (Marybeth) Scott and Cliff (Cathy) Scott, his daughters, Kathy (Hank) Luers, Janet (Jeff) Morris and Kim (Dale) Buchanan, and sister Alice (Dickie) Hanson. He is also survived by his 9 grandchildren, 5 great grandchildren, with two additional great grandchildren on the way.
