



## Janice Ann Ball

December 31, 1939 - April 5, 2016

Janice Ann Ball of Waldorf, Maryland, died on Tuesday, April 5, 2016 at the University of Maryland Charles Regional Medical Center in La Plata.

She was 76 years old.

Born on December 31, 1939 in Muncie, Indiana, she was the daughter of the late Gladys Mae and the late James William Abernathy. After graduating Central High School (Evansville, IN) in 1957, she moved to the D.C. area, where she was employed for a number of years by the Federal and Prince Georges County governments, and Automated Graphics Systems. Later, Jan was an Administrative Assistant with the National Rifle Association for 27 years until her retirement. She was a life member of the NRA and was a past member of the Marlboro Volunteer Fire Department Ladies Auxiliary and several bowling leagues. She was also a frequent entrant of cakes in the Charles County Fair, where she won a number of ribbons over the years.

Jan enjoyed spending time with family and friends, traveling and other adventures with her beloved "JR", reading, playing cards and board games, knitting and crocheting, collecting recipes, cooking and baking.

She twice survived breast cancer, which she faced with her characteristic strength and humor.

Abernathy.
