He worked primarily in retail and for over the last 12 years he was an employee of Hooks and Hangers in La Plata's Hawthorne Center through the Supported Employment Program of Spring Dell Center, Inc. Jeffrey was recently elected Treasurer of the Kiwanis AKTION Club as the 2011 representative for Spring Dell Center. As an avid Redskins fan, he will best be remembered for his never ending enthusiasm for football.
