OBITUARY

Jimmy R. Bull, of Waldorf, Maryland, died on Sunday, June 3, 2012 at his residence. He was 72 years old.

Born on April 11, 1940 in Clements, Oklahoma, he was of James William Bull and Katherine Blanch Hopkins Bull. Chief Master Sergeant Bull served 28 years in the United States Air Force and worked as Communications Chief on Air Force One for five U. S. Presidents starting in 1972. Prior to this, during his tour in Hawaii, he also flew rescue support for several Apollo Space Flight Missions. Chief Bull enjoyed his military career immensely and traveled extensively throughout the world. Post retirement, he worked E-Systems/Raytheon for 12 years in the Washington, DC area. He also enjoyed his hobby as a licensed ham radio operator, where he made many good friends throughout the globe.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 52 years, Edith Bull, whom he married in Frankfurt Germany; two sons Thomas Frederick Bull and his wife Debera Bull of Waldorf, MD, Keith Allen Bull and his fiancée Debra Maher of Bryantown, MD; two granddaughters Stacy Bull of Thurmont, MD, and Jessica Bull of Bryantown, MD; one

grandson Aaron Bull of Morgantown, WV; one great grandson Memphis Thomas Rogers of Thurmont, MD; two brothers George Bull of Tennessee and John Bull of Oklahoma, along with their wives and family.
