He was especially proud of taking one of his state court cases in the 1980's to the Supreme Court. The court ruled 8 to 1 in his favor, extending the Federal Interest Policy at issue to the Law of the Land. He served in the United States Air Force as a Staff Sergeant during the Vietnam War from 1967 to 1971. He lived the good life by the scriptures. He had wonderful days with family and friends, just not enough years. His family was always his first priority. He loved to travel, always had a good sense of humor and the ability to see the positive in even the most tragic events.
