John William O'Hara, Sr., 65 of La Plata, Maryland passed away on May 1, 2024 in Washington, DC. He was born on July 13, 1958 in Boston, Massachusetts to the late James Morrison Sr., and Lois Rosemary (Head) O'Hara.

John was a dedicated family man, who never knew a stranger. He always had a big smile on his face, a joyful demeanor, an eagerness to listen and a willingness to offer sound advice. He was an incredibly supportive Husband and Father who always showed up and was always there to put his family first.

In 1979 John married Annmarie, his devoted wife of 45 years, and together they moved to Maryland, where he pursued a career with the United States Capitol Police. In 1985 they moved to Southern Maryland where they raised their family.

John was deeply involved in volunteering throughout his life. He dedicated his time to the Southern Maryland Youth Organization (SMYO) where he coached his and many other children in soccer, baseball and softball, he served multiple roles on their Board of Directors then as President of SMYO for many years. John also coached girls' softball for the Jaycees Spirit, The Charles County Youth League and La Plata High School.

In 1991, John joined the Greater Waldorf Jaycees, where he went on to volunteer for more than 32 years. One of his most cherished projects was co-chairing the Greater Waldorf Jaycees Field of Dreams at Laurel Springs Park

in La Plata, MD, alongside his wife and daughter. In addition to his volunteer endeavors, John was a big-time sports fan who treasured his hometown teams and loved watching those games with family and friends. He found tremendous joy in the memories of each time spent with those he loved; the family gatherings, on the ballfields, the Jaycee cruises, the Super Bowl parties, Camp Merrick, dinner outings to his favorite places, Riverside trips, breakfast at the hall watching football every Sunday with Frank, and all of the Jaycee events and bingo nights with the players and volunteers who became friends.

John leaves behind a remarkable legacy of passion for helping others. He is survived by his loving wife Annmarie O'Hara; Children John O'Hara, Jr., Shaun O'Hara, Brian O'Hara (Marisa), and Shannon O'Hara; Grandchildren Trinity Flammer, John O'Hara, III., Jacob O'Hara, Olivia O'Hara, and Conor O'Hara; Siblings James O'Hara Jr., Diane O'Hara, long-time childhood friend; Billy Petras and family, long-time friends; Alex Karatik, Jim Clement, CJ Copsey, Bryan Myers, Charlie Padgett, Steve Chappelle, Mac McGuire, and The Jameson's, special in-laws, nieces, nephews and a host of other family members and friends.

Family was the most important thing to John. He held the title of reigning Family Game-Night Champion as well as undefeated in the Annual 4th of July "Tourney" with his brother in law "Sarge", often boasting about his victories to the rest of us, but the biggest brags came from his adoration of being "Grampa" to his grandchildren, who were the light of his life. He actively participated in each of their lives, he loved spoiling Trinity "George", strategizing fantasy football picks with "Johnson", head-to-head Yahtzee competitions with "Jake", indulging in Dairy Queen trips with Olivia, and relishing in the meeting the newest addition, Conor.

His light, his love, his laugh, his selflessness, his energy, his jokes and his defining Boston accent will be sorely missed, and his absence deeply felt by his family, friends, Jaycee family, and our entire community.

Visitation will be held on Thursday May 16th from 2-4pm and 6-8pm, at Raymond's Funeral Home in La Plata, Maryland.

A service will be held Friday May 17th, starting at 12pm in Raymond's Chapel, followed by interment at St. Mary's Newport Catholic Church Cemetery, in Charlotte Hall, MD.

The Family will host a Celebration of Life on Friday, May 17th, at 6:30pm at The Greater Waldorf Jaycees Center in Waldorf, Maryland.
