Mr. John C. Shea, Jr., 72, of Waldorf, MD passed away peacefully on Monday, July 1, 2013 at University of Maryland Medical Center. He was born and raised in Washington, DC, the son of John C. Shea and Mildred Shea Davis. He was a graduate of Anacostia High School Class of 1959. Mr. Shea served seven years in the U.S. Marine Corps Reserves, 1st ITR NCB, Camp Lejune, NC. He retired in Waldorf, MD after 38 years with Washington Gas Light Co. He was a member of the Greater Waldorf Jaycees, Elk Lodge #2421, and Quarter Century Club at Washington Gas Light Co. He enjoyed his retirement with his family at home, vacationing in Myrtle Beach, SC, and continuing to work, most recently as a security officer at College of Southern Maryland.

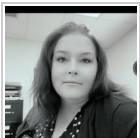

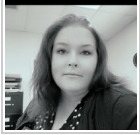

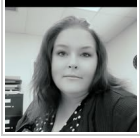
