Jose Santos Santos, 90, of Bryans Road, Maryland, passed away on March 5, 2021 at Adventist White Oak Health Care in Silver Spring.

Born on March 24, 1930 in Caloocan, Philippines, he is the son of the late Idgmidio Santos and Maria Santos. Fondly known as Joe, Mr. Santos served in the U. S. Navy for over 20 years before being Honorably Discharged at the rank of Chief Petty Officer. He later worked as a Respiratory Therapist at Hadley Memorial Hospital in Washington, DC. Joe was a member of the Knights of Columbus Council number 5317, St. Columba Church, Oxon Hill and a member of St. Mary Star of the Sea Catholic Church in Indian Head. 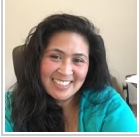

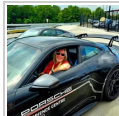
