



## Joseph Perrie, Jr.

April 13, 1944 - September 26, 2008

Joseph Summers Perrie Jr., of Federalsburg, passed away at his farm on Friday, September 26, 2008. He was 64.

He was born on April 13, 1944, in Washington, DC, the son of the late Joseph Summers Perrie Sr. and Charlotta Ann Elliott Perrie.

He graduated from Gwynn Park High School Class of 1962 in Brandywine, MD. He was a tobacco and grain farmer until his retirement. He also was a welder, mechanic, and owned and operated Perrie's Garage in Brandywine-Baden, MD.
