



## Joseph Snell, Sr.

January 9, 1922 - January 17, 2011

Joseph Elmer “Joe” Snell, Sr., 88, of Waldorf, MD, died January 17, 2011, at his residence.

Mr. Snell was a Dairyman with Embassy Dairy and Thompson’s Dairy for 52 years and a Mail Handler at Union Station in Washington, DC for 20 years. He was a Veteran of the United States Army, having served in the Pacific Theater during World War II and a member of St. Peter’s Catholic Church in Waldorf, MD.
