Beginning as a toddler, Karen had a voracious appetite for reading which remained with her into adulthood. As a teenager, she became a page at the Charles County Public Library where she had spent many happy hours. She quickly became known for her intellect as well as for her pleasant nature.

Karen's studies were always of utmost importance to her, resulting in her becoming Valedictorian of the class of 1978 at La Plata High School. Whilst there, she used her love of running to be on the cross-country and track teams, as well as enjoying tennis with her family. Her father taught her how to swim; she taught herself to play guitar as well as receiving piano lessons. Following her father's example, she learned the Morse Code and earned her novice radio amateur license.

After graduating from the University of Maryland with a bachelor's degree in computer science, Karen moved to Texas to begin her working life. She and Wayne met and subsequently married and welcomed two children, Jana and Carl, who currently live on the west coast. Sadly, a few years later, while living in Arizona, Karen learned of the passing of Wayne.

Karen is survived by her mother and brothers, Gerhard, John and Jonathan; children Jana and Carl; as well as her aunt, Sylvia and cousins of the United Kingdom. Many nieces and nephews also mourn the loss of Karen.
