Keith Allen Armstrong of Lothian, Maryland, died on Sunday, August 23, 2015 at his home. He was 59 years old.

Keith attended Surrattsville High School in Clinton, MD and graduated in 1974. After graduation, he enlisted in the U. S. Navy. He was later employed as an electronics technician for Electronic Security Services, Inc. (ESSI) in Upper Marlboro, MD and was a member of the Moose Lodge. Keith was of the Episcopal faith.
