



## Kenneth Alan Stump

December 24, 1947 - April 15, 2014

Kenneth Alan Stump of Waldorf, MD died on April 15, 2014 at his residence with Hospice. He was 66 years old.

Mr. Stump was a Statistician for 34 years with the Census Bureau and a veteran of the United States Army Infantry, having served during the Vietnam Era. He was a long-time member of the First Baptist Church of La Plata where he served as Deacon and Sunday School Director and he was named Deacon Emeritus.
