



Leo Carlton "Carl" Bowie, Jr.

March 15, 1943 - February 26, 2023

Carl was born on March 15, 1943 and was a lifetime resident of La Plata, MD. He worked as a Salesman with Sosmetal Products for many years and always enjoyed staying busy with various jobs. Carl loved baseball. In his youth, he was a slugger and pitcher for the Indian Head Indians and American Legion Post 82 teams. He was the leading slugger in the league twice and led the league in doubles, triples, runs scored, hits, RBI, pitching strikeouts. During that time, he was the only person to ever win two homerun titles, two Leading Pitcher Awards, MVP, and Manager of the Year Award. Carl was also an avid hunter and loved spending time with his family.

Carl is preceded in death by his parents, Leo C. Bowie, Sr. and Miriam Bowie; one son, Johnathan Bowie; and one sister, Gay Bowie.

He is survived by his children, Carlen Bowie, Mickey Bowie, Justin Bowie, and Russell Bowie; siblings, Gary Bowie, Cindy Bowie, and Gregg Bowie; and 4 grandchildren.

A visitation for Carl will be held on Wednesday, March 8, 2023 from 5-7pm at Raymond Funeral Chapel in La Plata, MD. His service will immediately follow at 7pm. Interment will be private.
