Leslie Floyd "Butch" "Pop-Pop" Roland, 75 of Waldorf, Maryland, died July 31, 2017 in White Plains, Maryland.

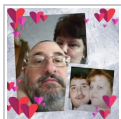

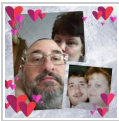
