Linda Kay (Holt) Black was taken to the Lord Jesus her Savior on August 19, 2022. Linda grew up on a farm in Bluff City, Tennessee. She professed Christ as her Savior and was thereupon baptized in 1951. In the Summer of 1963, she came to the Washington DC area to work for the Army Map Service where she met James F. Black who was in the same employment. After marrying in 1964, their first son, Jeffrey F. Black came along followed four years later by Jonathan. Jeffrey predeceased his mother, having passed away on June 2, 2022. James F. Black went to be with the Lord in March, 2016. The family worshipped at Camp Springs Community Church in [then] Camp Springs, Md for many years. Although Linda did work part-time occasionally, more importantly, she was a homemaker, for which we are so grateful. She worked part-time as a sales clerk at Peebles Department Store in Waldorf. After Jeff and Jonathan were grown, she worked as a secretary at Andrews Air Force Base and as a child-care worker at Kinder Care in Waldorf. Linda enjoyed art, and after having taken several classes at the College of Southern Maryland expressed her talents with oil on canvas; she also enjoyed flower gardening. Linda enjoyed singing and listening to gospel and bluegrass music; as well as listening to Christian radio programs. She played the piano at church and faithfully worshipped at Bible Baptist Church.

Linda is survived by her son Jonathan L. Black, her daughter-in-law Alaide Black and her two grandsons, Nathan and Ian Black. She is also survived by her sisters Kathy Hensley and Janet Rasnick, as well as a brother, Ronnie Holt, all of Bluff City, TN.
