Loudell Mitchell "Peggy" Kennedy, age 94, of Fort Washington, MD, died on December 23, 2016 at the Charleston Senior Community Center in Waldorf, MD.

Peggy was a Personnel Specialist of the U.S. Department of Agriculture for 50 years and a member of Whitehall Baptist Church in Accokeek, MD, where she was a member of the Jolly Timer Choir. She was also a Sunday School teacher at her former church, Fort Foote Baptist Church. She was an Actor/Director/Stage Manager for many years with a theatre group in Northern Virginia. She was the oldest member of the Capitol Yacht Club, where she was known as a very good sailor. She loved traveling, especially on cruises. She was also a lover of Traditional Jazz and a member of the Potomac River Jazz Club.

She was daughter of Arthur Thomas Rowe and Grace McClellan Rowe. In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her first husband of 60 years, Scott Mitchell.

Peggy is survived by her husband, of 5 years, Henry C. Kennedy, Jr.; one step-daughter, Lydia Berry and her husband Thomas; and two step-sons, Joseph Kennedy and John Kennedy, and his wife Dawn.
