Louis Dennis Grasso, 83, passed away at his beloved home Ellenwood in LaPlata, Maryland on March 4, 2023. He was born in Washington, D.C. on November 8, 1939 to Evelyn C. and Louis S. Grasso.

Louis enjoyed a career in the real estate and marketing industries for nearly four decades and was a licensed broker in multiple states. He was the founder and President of the Grasso Realty Group, The Marina Specialists, and CEO of Washington Suburban Mortgage with multiple offices on the east coast. He served as the Co-Trustee of Mid Atlantic REIT, Chairman of the holding company for Southern Floridabanc, and was the Marketing Director for the Washington, Maryland, and Virginia area for National Commercial Real Estate Franchise. He served on the Charles County Planning Commission for eight years, including two years as its chairman, and served six years as Chairman of the County's Economic Development Commission.
