Madeline Badovinac, 72, of Waldorf, MD, died September 12, 2011, at her residence with Hospice.

Mrs. Badovinac owned and operated Quality Carry-Out in Waldorf, MD from 1979-1982 and owned and operated Madeline's Catering throughout the late 80's and early 90's.
