



## Margaret Cameron McIntosh

December 3, 1930 - April 23, 2021

Margaret Cameron "Meg" McIntosh, of Accokeek, MD passed away on April 23, 2021.

Meg was born December 3, 1930 to William "Wilbur" and Elizabeth Williams in Tampa Florida. She attended the University of Southern Mississippi and earned a BS degree in Criminal Justice and served as a Deputy Sheriff in Harrison County MS. In the late 70's Meg was a security guard with the National Space Technology Laboratories in Pearl, MS where NASA test-fired the fuel for the Space Shuttle main engines program. She then moved to St. Louis, MO to work with the Department of Defense and as a Contract Specialist for the US Army. She was then transfer to the Boston area to continue working with the DOD and lived there for a few years before moving to Accokeek, MD for the DOD. Moving to Accokeek, MD afforded her the opportunity to live near her daughters and grandchildren. Meg retired in 2005.

Meg married Wade Hannah, Sr. in 1948 and had 9 children. They lived in Columbia SC, Charleston SC, New Orleans LA, La Ceiba, Honduras and Pass Christian, MS.
