Margaret Mary Renner (Margie), 92, of Waldorf MD died peacefully at University of Maryland Charles Regional Medical Center, La Plata, MD, on Sunday, May 26, 2024.

Margie was born on October 14, 1931, in Washington DC to the late Margaret Mary (Gruss) and Emil Carl Renner.
