Marian Katherine Johnson de Regt died in Waldorf, Maryland at the age of 97 on November 18, 2019 with her family by her side.

Marian was born to Anastasia and Lee Johnson in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania on August 18, 1922. She graduated from Hunter College High School in New York City in 1939 and attended Hunter College and the College of Puget Sound, graduating in 1944. Marian met Pieter de Regt while attending Hunter College and they married in 1942. After moving from the west coast to Virginia in 1960, Marian taught third grade at St. Stephen's School from 1964 to 1970 and then worked for the Federal government at National Science Foundation until she retired.

Marian is predeceased by her husband of 60 incredible years, Pieter de Regt, and her brother Basil Johnson. She is lovingly remembered by her children, John, Paul, Mark and Jan; their spouses; and her eight grandchildren.
