



Martha Garrett Cooper

May 31, 1944 - October 17, 2024

Martha Garrett Cooper passed away on October 17, 2024 at Georgetown University Hospital in Washington DC. She was born on May 31, 1944 in the family farmhouse in Carroll County, Maryland, near Taneytown. She was the youngest of six children of Merle and Aimee Garrett.

Martha graduated from Taneytown High school in 1962, where she was named “Best All-Around” female student in her class, in addition to being Student Council President and Captain of the cheerleading squad. After working for a year at Potomac Edison, she enrolled at the University of Maryland, College Park, from which she graduated with a Bachelor’s degree in Elementary Education in 1967.

On July 29, 1967, she married Richard A. Cooper, a 1967 graduate of the University of Maryland Law School. Shortly after their marriage, Mr. Cooper joined the Army Judge Advocate General’s Corps, in which he served on active duty for four years. Upon completing Richard’s military service, Martha and Dick purchased their first home in Poolesville, Maryland, where they resided for two years. In July 1974, they relocated to Waldorf, Maryland where they lived for 21 years, before moving to La Plata, Maryland in 1995. In addition to raising her children, Martha taught kindergarten for 13 years at St. Peter’s Catholic School in Waldorf, Maryland.

Martha is survived by her husband, Richard Cooper, her sisters Emma Devilbiss and Joanne Morrison, her children Richard Garrett Cooper (Kyoko), Aimee Virginia (Cooper) Starr (David), and Lee Ann (Cooper) Cohen (Jared). She is also survived by four grandchildren: Samuel Starr, Anna Starr, Sean Cohen, and Paul Cohen.

Martha was a loving wife, mother, mother-in-law, and grandmother, who will be missed greatly by her family and friends. May God bless her and keep her forever.

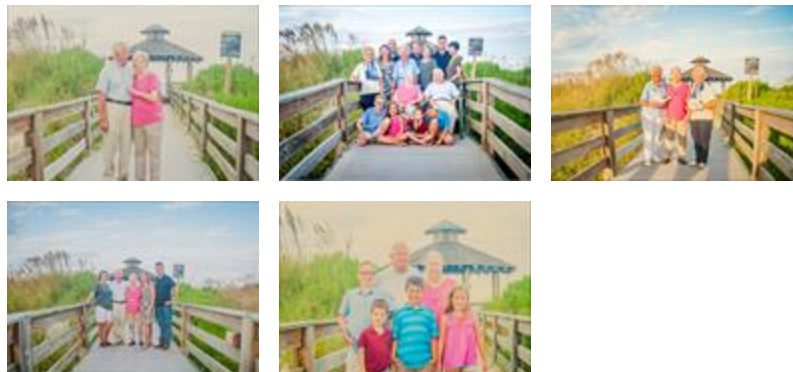
