January 29, 1916 - September 5, 2009

Martha “Tommy” Elizabeth Miller, 93, of Silver Spring, MD, died September 5, 2009, at the Mandeville House in Waldorf, MD.

Mrs. Miller grew up in Barbourville, Kentucky. After high school, Mrs. Miller moved to North Carolina, where she worked in retail management. During World War II, she worked for the U. S. Army as a Bookkeeper at Fort Bragg and at Camp Butner in North Carolina. She worked as a Bookkeeper for other businesses over the years. Her last position was for her husband Ted Miller’s law practice in Prince George’s County, Maryland. Mrs. Miller was very active in the Democratic Party and served as a leader. She worked tirelessly for the causes of civil rights, and world peace for her entire life. She was also very involved in her Unitarian Universalist denomination. She was the Religious Education Director at the Rockville Unitarian Universalist Church. She was an active member at the Cedar Lane Unitarian Universalist Church in Bethesda, where she was a pastoral care giver. During the early 60's, she served one year as the Maryland State Chairman for the March of Dimes.

Born in Judson, NC, she was the daughter of the late Christena Kennedy and the late Edward “Ed” P. Jackson.

Predeceased by her parents; her sisters, Vivian Berridge and Alma Walker; her brother, Ed P. Jackson Jr.

Survived by her daughters, Mollie Thorn and her husband Philip Thorn of Waldorf, MD; Jane Hallstrom and her husband Frank Hallstrom of Burlington, NC; Anne Robertson and her husband Michael Robertson of La Plata, MD; sister, of Vicki Bowen; also survived by 11 grandchildren, 11 great grandchildren, numerous nieces, other relatives and friends.

Mrs. Miller donated her body to the Howard University Medical Center Anatomical Donation Program.
