Martin "Marty" Shawn Spellacy, 63, passed quietly at George Washington University Hospital on November 3, 2021. Marty was pre-deceased by his parents, Martin Thomas Spellacy and Mary Ann Spellacy as well as his brother, Carl Joseph Spellacy and brother-in-law Jolly H. Kitts, Jr.

Marty is survived by his sisters, Irene Mary Kitts and Kathleen Carmel Quade (David); his nieces, Christy Spellacy Lane (Jeremie) , Colleen Spellacy, Sara Spellacy, Shannon Spellacy; his nephew, Shawn Spellacy; and his great nieces and nephews, Krislynn, Abbey, Jaxson, Ethan and Emily.

Marty graduated from La Plata High School in 1976. He was employed by the Bakery, Confectionary and Tobacco Union for a short period before taking a job in facilities with the FDIC. Marty retired as a Facilities Manager from the FDIC in 2012.

Marty loved sports, from playing high school football to league bowling, golf and darts – he loved participating as well as watching. His glory days playing high school football with his brother Carl and other friends were his fondest memories.

Marty also closely followed the American Legion baseball team with the Charles-St. Mary's Baseball League. Marty would attend weekly games during
