Marvin Guy Seger of Brandywine, MD, died on Thursday, May 28, 2009 at the Washington Hospital Center in Washington, DC. He was 81 years old.

Born in Washington, DC, he was the son of the late Gertrude Adams Seger and the late Guy Reuben Seger. A life long resident of Brandywine, Mr. Seger attended Gwynn Park High School and later served in the U. S. Army during World War II until he was Honorably Discharged in 1947. A farmer for most of his life, Mr. Seger enjoyed crossword puzzles and listening to Rush Limbaugh. He was very close to his nephews and nieces and he was known in the Baden community as being a close and compassionate friend.
