August 23, 1921 - July 1, 2016

Mary Ellen Cherubino, 94, of Clarksburg, entered into the Kingdom of God on Friday, July 1, 2016, at Sagepoint Senior Living in La Plata, MD.

Mary was born in Wilsonburg, WV on August 23, 1921, to the late Francesco and Teresa Allowatt. She spent her childhood and adolescent years in Shinnston, WV.

Mary married the late Frank Joseph Cherubino on September 4, 1948, and resided in Clarksburg, WV until his death, November 15, 2000.

Mary was a devout catholic and active member of the Immaculate Conception Catholic Parish.
