Mary Margaret Dressler of La Plata, Maryland, died on Sunday, September 2, 2012 at the Genesis Waldorf Center in Waldorf. She was 86 years old.

Born on December 21, 1925, she was the daughter of the late Leonard and Matilda Miller. Mrs. Dressler lived most of her life in Martinsville, OH and graduated from Martinsville High School Class of 1944. During World War II, she worked as a teletype operator for the Western Union office in Cincinnati, Ohio sending out telegrams to families of the soldiers injured, missing, or killed. She met her husband, Alvin D. Dressler while working as Western Union night manager at the Netherland Hilton. They were married for 45 years. She served as Grand Worthy Matron of the Order of the Eastern Star in Martinsville, Ohio and as Past State Counselor of Ohio of the Daughters of America. Mrs. Dressler had a lifelong devotion to patriotism and preserving the Christian Values of the United States.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Dressler was preceded in death by her beloved granddaughter, Stephanie Louise Nohe.
