Maurice Eugene "Gene" Foster, 86, of Franklin, NC, formerly of Indian Head, MD, died May 10, 2010, at Calvert Memorial Hospital.

Mr. Foster was an Item Manager with the Department of Defense for over 15 years. He was a veteran of the United States Army, serving during WWII in the European Theater where he was awarded the Purple Heart.
