Milton Fred Hein, Jr., 78, of Newburg, MD, died February 24, 2010, at Civista Medical Center, La Plata.

Mr. Hein was the owner and operator for 40 years of Mil-Mar, Inc., which he founded in 1968. It was the first custom home builders in Charles County.
