



Nancy Rae Markley

March 23, 1936 - February 4, 2021

Nancy Rae Markley, age 84 of Pomfret, Maryland died February 4, 2021 at the University of Maryland Charles Regional Medical Center in La Plata, Maryland surrounded by her entire family.

Nancy was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. She was a homemaker and a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Pomfret, Maryland. Some of her noteworthy accomplishments: a member of the American Legion Aux. 136 in Greenbelt, Maryland, Miss Greenbelt in the early 50's, and the USO shows for the troops in the 50's. She worked for Parks and Recreation and the Charles County Humane Society. She was a Foster Mother for six children, was a Poms Coach at Thomas Stone, McDonough, and La Plata high schools, and was a teacher of various majorette groups.

She was the daughter of Hilbert Otto Kurth and Helen Ann Meier Kurth. She is survived by her husband, James Markley, Sr.; her son, James Markley, Jr. and his fiancé Becca; and her daughters, Deborah Asher and her husband Gary, and Robin Sikorski and her husband Craig. She is also survived by six grandchildren and two great grandchildren.
