January 7, 1941 - December 1, 2013

Norman L. Lynch of Charlotte Hall, Maryland, died at the University of Maryland Charles Regional Medical Center in La Plata, MD on December 1, 2013. He was 72 years old.

Born on January 7, 1941 in Roxana, Delaware, he was the son of the late Helen Evelyn and the late Roland Vester Lynch. Mr. Lynch served in the U. S. Navy for 21 years and was Honorably Discharged as a Chief Petty Officer and an Aviation Structural Mechanic. He then worked on heating, air conditioning and refrigeration on Capitol Hill. He was a Mason with the Patuxent Masonic Lodge for 39 years, a member of the Fleet Reserve Association and a member of the American Legion Post 209 in District Heights, MD. He enjoyed collecting stamps and coins and watching his grandchildren grow up.
