Patricia (Pat/Patti) Irene Howe, 77, longtime resident of La Plata, MD, passed away on June 14, 2023 at Washington Hospital Center due to complications after open heart surgery. Pat was a devoted Catholic who loved the Lord, and a faithful member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in La Plata, where she served in Our Lady's Sodality and hosted the rosary group in her home several times a week. She was actively involved and served as president of Charles County Right to Life. Patti loved spending time with her family, adopted family, friends, and helping, teaching, and caring for children. She enjoyed traveling to beautiful and holy destinations, making a pilgrimage to Lourdes, France, and visiting family from Maine to Florida.

Born in Washington, D.C. on March 22, 1946, Patti was the youngest child of Irene Teresa Green and William Mezick Green. Earning her Bachelor degree in Education from Bowie State University, Pat spent many years as a gifted special education teacher in Charles County parochial and public schools. After retirement, Pat stayed active by teaching Adult ESL classes in the community, sharing stories, jokes and laughs with family and friends, both old and new, and shopping for thoughtful gifts.
