



## Patricia Ann Rosetta

July 27, 1939 - January 18, 2018

Patricia “Pat” Rosetta age 78, passed away the evening of 01-18-18 at Genesis Nursing facility in Waldorf. Born in Washington D.C., she was the daughter of the late William and Viola Hendricks.
