I remember when Daddy Lowe passed away in January 1962, it was Pat who came home to New York and met us after school that day, to let us know he was gone. Pat and Harry meant so much to my beloved grandparents. My sister, Dorie, and I would go down to Washington/Maryland at Easter time and summer vacations. We'd spend time at our grandparents and cousins in the District, and with Pat and Harry and the kids in Maryland.
