Patricia Kay “Patty” Lemko of Port Tobacco, Maryland, died on Saturday, November 10, 2012 at George Washington Hospital in Washington, DC. She was 63 years old.

Mrs. Lemko graduated from La Plata High School in 1967 and attended Charles County Community College.
