Patrick Francis Fogarty, age 81 of Waldorf, MD, died on August 22, 2015 at the Charles County Hospice House in Waldorf, MD.

Patrick was born in Brooklyn, NY on December 21, 1933. The son of Irish immigrants, he spent his childhood in Brooklyn with his parents and two sisters. He graduated from the University of California at Berkeley in Berkeley, CA with a degree in history. He will be remembered by friends, family and complete strangers for his legendary ability to tell a joke (and the same jokes over and over and over). His passion for and knowledge of history, especially ancient Roman history, was tremendous. He loved to travel the world, especially on a cruise ship, and took his family to many ancient ruins. He cherished his two grandchildren and absolutely loved his son-in-law's cooking. He missed his wife so very much but enjoyed the last few years at The Maples in La Plata. He loved an audience and had one to the end with a roomful of people who cared for and loved him deeply. Words will never adequately describe the loving care and support Patrick and his family received during his stay at the Hospice House of Charles County. Patrick was one of the happiest people you could meet, and he loved and lived life to its fullest. He will be missed.

He is the son of the late Patrick Fogarty and the late Ellen O'Keefe. He is also predeceased by his wife of 50 years, Eileen T. Fogarty (nee Murphy); his

parents; and two sisters, Eileen (Frain) and Kathleen (McCarthy).

He is survived by his only daughter, Cara (John) Stempin-Fogarty of La Plata, MD; his grandchildren, Magen Stempin and Hunter Stempin, both of La Plata, MD; and many nieces and nephews.

Visitation will be on Thursday, October 8, 2015 from 5-8PM with a Wake Service at 7PM at the Raymond Funeral Service Chapel, 5635 Washington Avenue, La Plata, MD 20646. 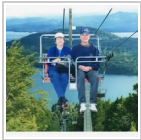

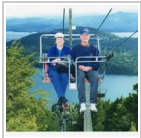

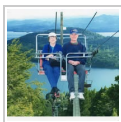
