



## Paul Adams DiDomenico

January 24, 1957 - April 28, 2015

Paul Adams DiDomenico of La Plata, Maryland, died on Tuesday, April 28, 2015 at the Charles County Hospice House in Waldorf. He was 58 years old.

Born on January 24, 1957 in Washington, DC, he was the son of Lois Adams DiDomenico and the late John C. DiDomenico. Mr. DiDomenico, fondly known as "Pokey", was a laboratory technician with PEPCO. He was a member of the Waldorf Jaycees, the Waldorf Lions Club and the St. Charles Sportsman's Club. He attended New Life Church in La Plata.
