Paul Wayne Loving, 63, of Waldorf, Maryland, passed away on Friday, July 23, 2021 at the University of Maryland Charles Regional Medical Center in La Plata.

Born on June 3, 1957 in King George, Virginia, he was the son of the late Jack Wayne Loving and June Ellen Loving. After graduating high school, Paul entered the U. S. When Paul finished, he would hand me the list, tell me "we're going to bust the budget, because like everything around here, they ran it into the ground". It was my job, to go over the list with Paul, get the critical parts for the repair and stay within budget. Needless to say, we had some heated discussions about what is truly critical.

Over the years, Paul and I shared a high level of respect for each other. If Paul needed help with a part or couldn't notify a supervisor, he would call me.

Paul never said "Hi or "Hello", he always said, "Hey Sweetie, whatcha doing?". I always laughed. Didn't matter if I was eating dinner or awoken from a sound sleep, I laughed. Paul and I made each other laugh all of the time and certainly at each other's expense.

Even as this horrible disease challenged Paul everyday, his texts to me always made me laugh.

I will miss our conversation about family, work and all of our lives experiences, but most of all, I will miss our laughter.
