Philip Howard Ayer of Waldorf, Maryland died on June 18, 2008 at Georgetown University Hospital in Washington, DC. He was 79 years.

Born on December 5, 1928 in Cincinnati, Ohio, he was the son of the late Philip Melvin Ayer and Katherine Viola Melin Ayer. He worked as an Administrator with General Dynamics and for a security company. He served in the U. S.
