May 6, 1964 - September 20, 2015

Reverend Philip Neal Warren died suddenly in his home on September 20, 2015 at the age of 51. He was serving as A/Captain at The Salvation Army Adult Rehabilitation Center in Hempstead, NY.

He was preceded in death by his brother Michael David Warren.

Phil grew up in Maryland and Nassau, Bahamas, where he enjoyed woodworking, motorcycling, hunting, fishing as well as music and the activities of his father's pastorates. He also proudly served in the U.S. Navy for a few years.

He leaves behind his loving wife of 6 years, Yvonne A. Guillaume Warren, two adult sons Sean and Marc, his siblings Roger, Robin and Steve and his parents Dr. John and Vivian Warren.
