Rachel Patricia Christmas was born to 4th November 1967 at Park Royal Middlesex Hospital in London, United Kingdom. She was the firstborn to her parents, William Gordon Christmas and Roselyn Anris Christmas. She grew up in St. Neots, Cambridgeshire, UK, and attended and graduated from Ernulf School. She moved to the United States in December 2004 and married Curtis Moore in May 2005. Her only child, Jourdan, was born on 14th August 2007, and he was her pride and joy; she loved him more than life itself.

Rachel was a successful IT trainer and spent many years training employees at Morgan Lewis in Washington DC. Rachel passed away peacefully at Georgetown Hospital on 24th January, 2026
