Ralph Anthony Dixon, age 91 of Waldorf, Maryland, died October 11, 2020 at the University of Maryland Charles Regional Medical Center in La Plata, Maryland.

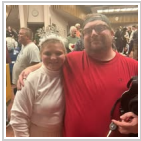

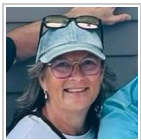
