Ralph Morquecho, of La Plata, Maryland, died on April 16, 2016 at his residence, surrounded by his family. He was 81 years old.

Born in Laredo Texas, raised in Okmulgee Oklahoma. Served in the Marine Corp from 1953-1957 and assigned to the 1st Marine Corp division in Korea. After being honorably discharged from the Marine Corps he moved to Washington DC in 1958. Was employed by the department of the army Map Service where he met his wife of 53 years, Evelyn Morquecho. In 1962 he transferred to David Taylor Model Base, where he worked until he retired in 1986.

Ralph Morquecho was a volunteer coach for the Catholic Youth Organization in basketball and baseball for Church of the little flower and was volunteer coach with the Montgomery county department of parks and Recreation. Ralph was a member of the Potomac chapter of Veterans of Foreign Wars and served a term as President. From 1975-2000 he was a resident of Cabin John Maryland and then moved to Southern Maryland, Charles County Maryland. Ralph was an avid duck pin bowler and belonged to the Palisades League for over 10 years.
