



Ramon Jesus Medina

July 21, 1928 - June 11, 2023

Ramon Jesus Medina, 94 of Clinton MD passed on June 11,2023. He was born on July 21,1928 to Juan and Veronica Medina, in Ponce Puerto Rico After high school he entered the Episcopal Seminary of St. Michaels in Santurce, PR. After two years he departed for New York to attend the University, but opted to join the Marine Corp and served from 1948 to 1952. He served in the Korean War. Upon return Ramon attended the Marine Officer's Training School in Quantico completing it as Second Lieutenant and resigned.

Honorably Discharged from the U.S. Marine Corp he returned to San Juan, Puerto Rico. There he founded and ran a multimillion-dollar Television Advertising Agency until 1960. In addition, Ramon was the Manager / Program Director and Program Producer of the WORA TV in San Juan, Puerto Rico and was a Consultant and General Manager at WPRA in San Juan.

Ramon established the DINA Food Corporation producing the seasoning Sofrito Dina which he sold to Goya before relocating to the mainland. Ramon remained in the service of the Federal Government with the Department of Agriculture and NASA during the Mercury and Gemini era. From 1967 to his retirement in 1987 he served with the State Department of the United States Information Agency at the Voice of America, with a target area of central and South America and the Caribbean.

Ramon is survived by his wife, Luba, children, Joann, David, and Linda

Samantha, six grandchildren, Christina, Victor Jr., Kaitlyn, David Jr, Miguel and Stephen, and one great granddaughter Alison. He also leaves four siblings, Elba, Juan, Gladys and William, and numerous nieces and nephews. Visitation will be held on July 6, 2023 from 6-8 pm In Raymond Funeral Services Chapel. The next day on July 7, 1923, 10AM Mass will be held at St. Peters Catholic Church, in Waldorf Maryland.
