



## Raymond William Armbrester

August 7, 1941 - April 30, 2021

Ray Armbrester was a kind and loving husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle and friend. He never met a stranger and treated everyone as family. His battle with serious medical issues in recent years showed his courage in facing life challenges with a smile. Despite the pain, Ray was a hero to many and remained strong until the end on April 30, 2021 at age 79.

He was born to Ted and Eva Armbrester on August 7, 1941 in Berkley County, West Virginia. After moving to Maryland, he met his wife, Christine. They were married for 46 years. He was a proud Grandad and Pappy to 9 grandchildren, 12 great grandchildren with two set to arrive this Summer, and 2 great great grandchildren. He is preceded in death by brothers Paul and Doug Armbrester and survived by his siblings, Mary Schottroff, Phyllis Perrell (Leroy), and
