



## Raymond Aloysius "Ray" Carroll

November 20, 1938 - April 9, 2014

Raymond A. Carroll of Waldorf, Maryland, died on Tuesday, April 9, 2014 at Suburban Hospital in Bethesda, MD. He was 75 years old.

Born on November 20, 1938 in Washington, DC, he was the son of the late Howard B. Carroll Sr. and the late Marie T. Cunningham Carroll.
