



Raymond Holt Jr.

July 17, 1930 - November 9, 2012

Raymond Clinton “Clint” Holt Jr. of White Plains, Maryland, died on November 9, 2012 at his home. He was 82 years old.

Born on July 17, 1930 in Arlington, Virginia, he was the son of the late Raymond C. Holt Sr. and the late Dorothy Elliott Holt. He grew up in Arlington and graduated from Washington and Lee High School in 1948. He then went to work for what is now known as Defense Mapping Agency, from which he retired after 37 years of service. From 1952 to 1954, he served in the U. S. Army. In 1970, he moved to White Plains. All his life he loved sports, golf, tennis, football (a Washington Redskins fan), baseball and fast pitch softball. In 1990, he was inducted into the Greater Washington Fast-pitch Softball Hall of Fame. He also coached youth football teams for many years. He enjoyed spending time with family and friends, traveling, time at the beach and games.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his daughter, Donna Leigh Holt; brother Eugene “Buddy” Holt; sisters Edith Lamb and Lorraine Carter.

He is survived by his wife Maudie Fennell Holt; sons Jeffrey R.

and his wife Shaunda of La Plata, MD and Michael E. and his wife Holt of Colonial Beach, VA; sisters Margaret Connor, Patricia Holliday, Marion Irby and Norma Lee Kearns; grandchildren Brandon, Joshua, John and Emily Holt and Claire Runkles.
